A disciplined person doesn’t need someone to tell

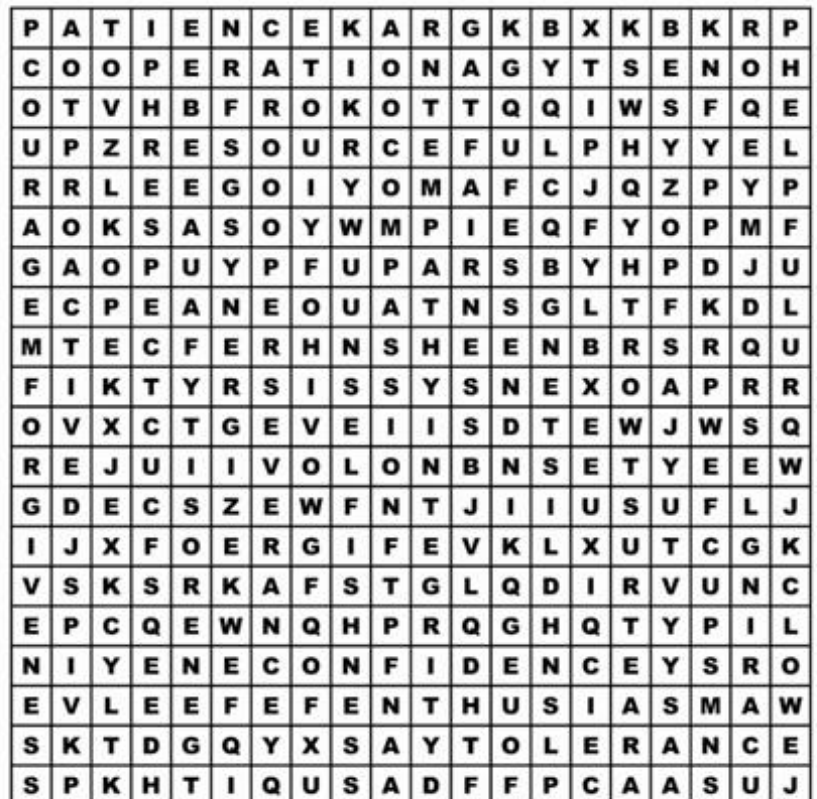

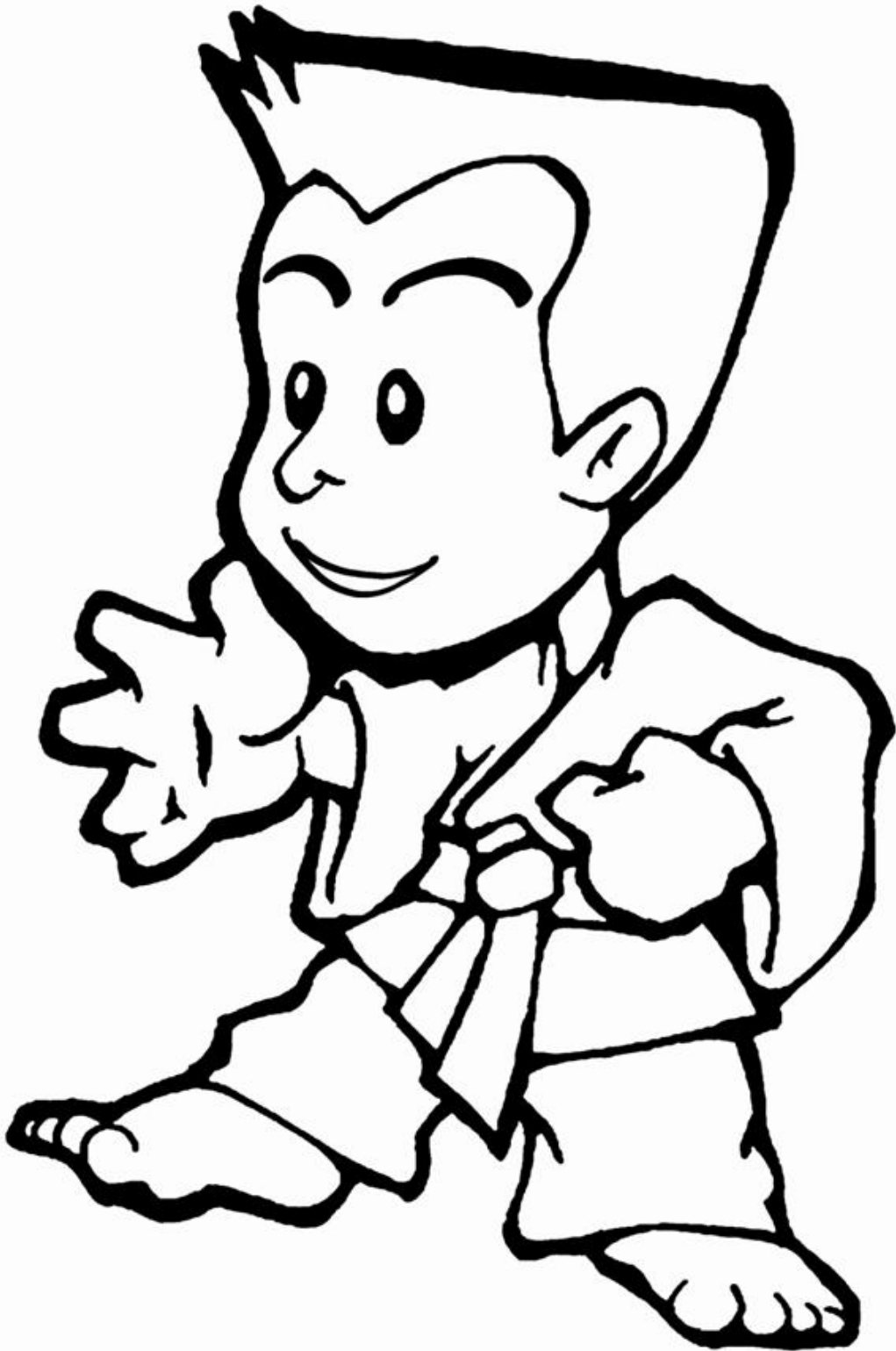
